Through Kingdom Builders Vision 100, we've now begun initial planning for FA's eventual expansion in South Calgary. With that, we launched our Seton Campus on Easter Sunday 2023. Now, nearly 300 attendees gather in the south at our 10:30 AM service time. By God's grace, we are establishing a strong gospel presence in the south while we make preparations for our future south property. These are milestones worth celebrating, and we give God all the glory!

As God has blessed and called First Assembly, He has called us to be a blessing. Let's continue sowing seeds of generosity, faith, and obedience, stretching beyond our regular giving to fulfill the Great Commission both globally and locally, so we can reach as many people with the Gospel as we can, everywhere we can.

2023 MISSIONS PROJECTS UPDATES

Through the generous giving of our community, we supported four projects that we brought forward during our Kingdom Builders Month in 2023. We are a community marked by celebration, and we want to celebrate with you what God has done! Thanks to our church community for their generous support as we continue to live on mission locally and globally!

GUINEA | SOFONIA HEALTH & TRAINING CENTRE

The leader of Guinea's national church, Reverend Bandjou Leno, along with Mission Global workers, Phil and Judy Bowler, are seeking to bring the gospel to Guinea while responding to the physical needs of Guinean children. Their aim is to practically and spiritually reach people with the message of the Gospel in one of the most unreached countries in Africa. Our support has enabled them to continue construction to the Sofonia Health and Training Centre

to the Sofonia Health and Training Centre.
The initial phase of the centre has already been completed with the installation of the roof, and the second phase currently underway! This centre will leave a lasting impact for generations to come.

URUGUAY | EMMANUEL REHABILITATION CENTRE

The Cetrulos, Mission Global Workers, were called to Uruguay to engage in ministry, reaching the lost and caring for the poor and marginalized, and to support the training for people of influence both spiritually and in their leadership. We came alongside their vision to open an orphanage and rehab center for men seeking to overcome addiction. Now their ministry is fully operational and funded solely by donations, primarily coming from Canada.



CAMBODIA | GLOBAL STUDENT CENTRE

The Global Student Center aims to reach university students in Cambodia through various ministries and programs that are offered to students. Many students have come for support, encouragement, and relationship connection! We supported their key initiative, called "Project 130 – Global Student Centre", which aims to improve the student center facility that currently only supports

space for 100 students in the city of Phnom Penh. We celebrate that we are now supporting Ian and Tiffanie Rowley, as FA Global Workers.





MISSIONS PROJECTS

We are full of faith and expectancy for how God is leading us to continue impacting the world with the life transforming presence of Jesus. This year, we are believing to support the following five Mission Projects!



CUBA | Training & Sending Global Workers

Finances to train and send Cuban global workers abroad are still a major challenge for the Cuban Church; however, with help and training from the PAOC, the Cuban church is now preparing to send out global workers of their own, in order to reach unreached people groups worldwide. Cuban global workers are able to travel more easily to some of the hardest-to-access nations on earth. This makes our support through this Kingdom Builders Missions incredibly impactful.

REPRODUCE

NIGERIA | Jinkai Initiative

Jinkai is a not-for-profit organization that works with families who have been adversely impacted by the ethno-religious clashes in Northern and North Central Nigeria. They are currently training over 48 young adults from displaced communities to equip them with practical skills for work in solar installation, brick laying and machinery fabrication to serve their communities.



REACH



URUGUAY | Emmanuel Rehabilitation Centre

We celebrate that the Emmanuel Rehabilitation Centre ministry is fully operational and funded solely by donations, primarily coming from Canada. This year we are making a special offering to support them in this new stage of their ministry. The Cetrulos are Mission Global workers who are called to support the lost and least of these in their country.



NORTH CENTRAL NIGERIA Restore Mission

With more than 2 million people internally displaced from predominantly Christian communities in Benue State, Nigeria, there is a huge need. Due to ongoing violent attacks from extreme Islamic Fulani herdsmen, almost a million are living in Internally Displaced Persons (IDP) camps in the state and there are more than 400,000 kids out of school. Our support will further assist Restore Mission to continue to meet needs in two of these camps through providing teacher salaries to support the education of kids and provide kids school lunch, along with various other evangelistic and ministry outreach initiatives.

REACH

JAPAN OPERATION MOBILIZATION

The OM team in Japan recently adopted a focus on evangelism and discipleship to reach the unreached within their own country. The team is also providing practical help after natural disasters, supporting established local churches, and initiating new expressions of church planting. As this ministry grows, they are seeing a need to raise up and train Japanese Christians to become disciple-makers.



REACH



YELLOWKNIFE & NORTHWEST TERRITORIES | PAOC

The need is great, and the time is now. God is calling us to make a difference in the lives of the people of the Northwest Territories. With a population of just over 44,000, spread across vast and challenging terrain (over half who reside in Yellowknife), the NWT reflects a mix of Indigenous cultures as well as growing ethnic diversity. There is a deep spiritual need and a lack of access to the gospel message. We are coming alongside the PAOC ABNWT district to send some of our best pastors and leaders from First Assembly to the North.

NEW FIRST ASSEMBLY CHURCH GLOBAL WORKERS



IAN & TIFFANIE ROWLEY CAMBODIA

Ian and Tiffanie Rowley are PAOC/PAONL global workers in Phnom Penh, Cambodia. Ian oversees Global Student Center and a dorm that aims to reach university students. They engage students through various ministries and programs that are offered at their center. Last year, we committed to supporting their Student Centre upgrades called "Project 130". This project is now complete, and they just recently celebrated the opening of the Global Student Center in Phnom Penh.

Prayer Points:

- Pray that these students would catch a vision for reaching their nation and that they will go out into the country of Cambodia as agents of change.



I & J RESTRICTED ACCESS NATION

We support Global Workers who are living and working in a region in the Middle East that is experiencing war. Our partner's mission and passion is to care for refugees and displaced residents in a variety of tangible ways, including putting on concerts, organizing programming for children and youth, and providing necessary items such as clothing, food boxes, furniture, appliances, etc. to those needing immediate physical help.

They are also involved in helping young people overcome drug and alcohol addictions in over 11 countries around the world.

Prayer points:

- For God to bring peace and comfort to the residents of this area at this incredibly difficult time
- For God to help them to know how to support most effectively those under their care.



PETER DOVE ASIA

Since 2002, Peter and Cavelle Dove have served in Asia, focusing on University Ministry and Community Development. They co-founded Imagine Thailand in 2008, connecting emerging leaders to marginalized communities. Their work spans redemptive entrepreneurship, leadership development, theological training, and university ministry. Peter serves as the PAOC Regional Director for Asia since 2016. The region hosts 100+ Global Workers in 18 countries, serving over 60% of the world's population and diverse religious communities. Peter also teaches in Asia, pictured here at a recent event in a restricted location with new believers. These followers are part of a rapidly growing house church movement in this region.

AFRICA - RESTRICTED ACCESS

Twenty years ago, there were no known Jesus followers among the Muslim people groups in this region. God continues to advance His Kingdom through Bible translation projects for the Koso* fishing peoples and rice farmers along the Niger River. One man in this people group has finished his training to become a pastor and is church-planting among his people. Scripture continues to be translated, recorded and distributed through radio programs, a Scripture app, film, websites and WhatsApp groups.

Prayer Points:

- Pray for all those who will hear the gospel message in their own language for the first time.
- Pray for Marko and Pauline who are serving in a restricted access nation among Muslim people groups.



W & A

RESTRICTED ACCESS

W & A been faithfully serving in this region of the world for over 30 years, and their vision has been guided by three primary goals: to plant churches, to train leaders, and to be a catalyst for unity among various ministries in their region. By God's grace, this vision has flourished over the years as they have seen the planting of several congregations resulting in 12 local churches.

Prayer Points:

- Pray for strength, wisdom and clarity as they serve in a restricted nation.
- Pray for safety and stronger ministry connections.

TESTIMONIES FROM GLOBAL WORKERS

RESTORING DIGNITY

"This past fall we have begun implementing dignity projects across multiple centers that have existing networks of women. We have provided training to 500+ women in the most impoverished communities ... while training up a team of facilitators that will allow us to reach 10,000 women over the coming year. The women are extremely grateful for the knowledge and the products we provide them.

In one of the sessions that was meeting in a side room of a mosque, the women literally rushed the table in a desperate attempt to get the products that were being given to them and knocked over the facilitator in the process. While this incident was slightly humorous, it shows the desperation and need of these women for the simplest things to restore dignity to their lives. We have also been working with Sudanese refugees who have fled the war and have come to our country.

Whenever possible, we try to have multiple colors and varieties for the women to choose from. We have lost count of the number of women who have deeply embraced our team members. For some, this is the first time they have been afforded the opportunity to choose something just for them. Dignity includes choice.

Prayer Request: Our team of facilitators is beginning to multiply into further locations and cities. Please pray for continued favour and financial provision to scale up to the demand that is before us." - J & R, Global Workers in North Africa.

FLO'S STORY

Jesus first showed himself to Flo* in a dream when she was a teenager about eighteen years ago. She'd never met any Christians or been in a church. She knew nothing of the Bible. She told her family, and even the imam, but no one seemed to know what to make of her dream.

She never felt loved by her parents. When she left school, she was hired as a model with the national TV station. The glamour didn't last long.

Her parents married her to an older rich man who was an alcoholic. She tried to help him, but the marriage didn't last. The dreams where Jesus appeared to her kept coming.

She thought she'd found the man she would marry. He loved her, and she loved him. However, his family didn't agree and required him to marry the arranged bride. She was three months pregnant with his child when he told her that he had married the other girl. She was heartbroken.

In a dream she cried out to Jesus, "Why do you allow me to suffer like this?" He gently replied, "When you suffer, I suffer. Call out to me. I will help you." Finally, she went and found a pastor and explained what she had been experiencing. He encouraged her to get baptized, but she had never read the Bible and simply said, "When Jesus tells me to get baptized, I will!"

Shortly after, Flo had a dream in which she asked Jesus, "Which religion do you like better than all the others?" Suddenly, a large shining white cross appeared. A hand came and swept anyway everything but the large cross. As soon as she awoke, Flo called the pastor and asked to be baptized. He suggested the following day, but she insisted that she needed to be baptized right away and the pastor took her to the river and baptized her.

God has given Flo a gift of healing. She has seen two people healed when she asked Jesus to touch them. She gives all the glory to God and knows that he has a special purpose for her life.

Please pray that Flo will find good Christian community, learn to love God's Word, and grow strong in her faith. Pray that she will raise her son to follow Jesus and see many of her Koso family come to follow Jesus.

Global Online



Alpha is a dynamic video-based course that is designed to initiate honest and open dialogue as we invite others new to faith to explore life, faith, and spirituality. The list could go on. We see hundreds of people impacted through Alpha between our Elbow Drive gatherings and the Alpha groups our youth students started in their high schools!

MINISTRY SCHOOLS


TEHILLAH CREATIVE SCHOOL (TCS)

Tehillah Creative School (TCS) is focused on a principal commitment to provide a comprehensive, hands-on educational opportunity in the arts. Dedicated to excellence and long-term success, we create a dynamic, challenging, and collaborative space for students who see the world through a creative lens. Creativity is valued, honoured, and respected, and we want to help give our students the tools to make a difference in the world.

"This year we simplified our focus, offering music lessons through traditional one-on-one lessons for electric and acoustic guitar, bass, drums, piano, and vocals. We also offer practical training in our TCS Band Session, where we put students together in band in a modern worship setting, allowing them to work and learn together. During the 2023 fall semester, we have had a total of 41 students, showing significant growth compared to last year with an average of 12 students each semester. Thanks to the generosity of our church community and FA Cares, we were able to sponsor 8 students per semester since June 2023 and lowered the cost of tuition making TCS one of the most affordable music schools in the city, while still paying our instructors a comparable wage."



TEHILLAH MINISTRY SCHOOL (TMS)



"This year we have 60 students, the highest number since TMS was started. However, it is not just the quantity of students that we are celebrating, but the quality. Our team has been blown away at the hunger for God and the desire to learn that all of our students have. God is raising up leaders in this city who are hungry for more of His presence! We also have been able to sow into the spiritual growth of our FA congregation by developing our Discipleship Pathway - Going Deeper classes to grow in love and understanding of the scriptures. These classes are a free opportunity for our FA community to "Go Deeper in the Word". This fall, we launched our first class, powered by TMS, on the Letter to the Romans with 150 people registered. As the Lord expands the tent of this house, so must also our knowledge of His word."



TEHILLAH YOUTH MINISTRY SCHOOL (TYMS)


At Tehillah Youth Ministry School, we believe that youth are not just the leaders of tomorrow, but they are the leaders of today. TYMS is equipping teenagers to be influential leaders marked by the character, passion and power of Christ. The school meets weekly with around 60-70 students who are passionately pursuing more of Jesus in their lives.



"Last year 49 students attended our ministry school, representing around 18 different churches and various denominations in our city. We are seeing God stir a new level of commitment and hunger in our students to be discipled and transformed into His image. This passion is not staying inside the walls of their churches but is leading them to actively live on mission for His Kingdom everywhere they go. Multiple students have started faith clubs, prayer groups, and have run alphas at their schools. Last December, TYMS organized a student-led Christmas party for new Ukrainian immigrants and refugees and saw several attendees give their lives to Jesus and start attending First Assembly Church. In the Spring, around 25 students plus several leaders traveled to Los Angeles to partner with the LA Dream Centre. Our students boldly shared their faith, served people at the Dream Centre, deeply loved people they encountered on the streets of LA, and saw various healings take place. Our students also participated in a Tehillah takeover on a Monday night and preached powerful messages on living lives on mission for Jesus."

But what truly set Sunnyside Camp apart is the strong sense of community and spiritual growth that is fostered throughout the week. Daily services, reading of the Word, prayer and worship services provide campers with the opportunity to connect with God and each other on a deep and meaningful level.

This gym is now a multi-use space for events, conferences and ministry gatherings.
